Multicultural Grants Scheme

The *Multicultural Grants Scheme* aims to:

- increase understanding of the culturally diverse community in which we live;
- celebrate and value cultural diversity;
- improve equality and tolerance in society; and
- increase participation by South Australians of all backgrounds in society.

WHAT ARE THE GRANTS FOR?

Grants are available for:

- 1 FESTIVALS**
- 2 PROJECTS AND EVENTS**
- 3 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**
- 4 USING THE MEDIA TO PROMOTE MULTICULTURALISM**

Initiatives that respond to the needs and circumstances of culturally and linguistically diverse young people and of rural and regional communities are encouraged.

WHO CAN APPLY

Applicants must:

- be incorporated organisations registered in South Australia;
- be not-for-profit organisations;
- be non-government;
- have an Australian Business Number; and
- have provided full Accountability Statements for previously funded projects which have been completed (if applicable).

Note that organisations that are not incorporated may be sponsored by an incorporated organisation that has agreed to be responsible for meeting all the grant conditions.

Organisations must demonstrate a need for the subsidy, including evidence of their current financial position, and must show they can administer the grant responsibly.

FESTIVALS

Multicultural Festivals should encourage the whole community in celebrating and valuing cultural diversity.

Small grants of up to \$3,000, or medium grants of between \$3,000 and \$15,000, may be provided to support not-for-profit community festivals that celebrate and promote South Australian ethnic community cultures.

Major grants above \$15,000 may be provided to assist large festivals to undertake major activities that involve more than one cultural group.

These festivals should:

- promote and celebrate cultural diversity;
- raise awareness and understanding of cultural diversity;
- reflect the broad cultural diversity of South Australia; and
- reach a broad audience across South Australia.

PROJECTS AND EVENTS

Projects and events should:

- support ethnic or multicultural organisations to promote an understanding of their cultures and heritages to the public;
- assist ethnic or multicultural organisations to work with service providers to improve access and equity in services provision;
- support ethnic or multicultural organisations to provide social and cultural support to their communities; or
- encourage and support individuals and groups from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds to participate in planning and decision-making processes of community and government organisations.

Small grants of up to \$2,500, or medium grants of between \$2,500 and \$10,000, may be provided to support projects and events organised mainly by and for one or a small number of cultural groups or organisations.

Major grants between \$10,000 and \$15,000 may be provided to support more far-reaching projects and events that reflect the broad cultural diversity of South Australia.

Applications should include information about:

- community support for the project or event;
- community involvement in the development, management and implementation of the project or event; and
- how the project or event will be managed.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Community Development Grants

Small Community Development Grants of up to \$2,500, or medium Community Development Grants of between \$2,500 and \$10,000, may be provided to support the establishment of new and emerging communities to manage their own affairs and provide basic services to their members.

These grants could be used to go towards the costs of essential equipment and materials to establish the group.

Major Community Development Grants

Major Community Development Grants between \$10,000 and \$15,000 may be provided to enable community clubs and organisations to:

- respond to urgent needs associated with changing circumstances and emerging requirements of their communities;
- pay up to 50% of the employment costs of a project officer or officers;
- promote positive relationships in the South Australian community; and
- become economically sustainable.

Major Community Development initiatives should help ethnic or multicultural community organisations strengthening their ability to manage their own affairs by:

- identifying clear purposes, goals and strategies for the organisation;
- ensuring all members of the community can participate fully in this process;
- developing the leadership, planning, management and implementation of skills across the community;
- establishing partnerships with other community and government organisations; and
- managing and adapting to change.

Major Community Development Grants are for:

- one-off community development initiatives; and
- are not for the provision of continuing services or programs.

Applicants will need to demonstrate that the proposed project:

- has strong support from across the community involved; and
- is likely to produce sustainable outcomes, which will continue well beyond the life of the funded project.

Organisations applying for a Major Community Development Grant are required to provide supplementary information with their application, as shown on the Application Form.

USING THE MEDIA TO PROMOTE MULTICULTURALISM

Media Projects using multicultural broadcasters and community newspapers should aim to:

- promote and celebrate cultural diversity;
- raise awareness and understanding of cultural and linguistic diversity; and/or
- promote language retention and learning.

Grants of up to \$3,000 may be provided to support projects that provide prominent exposure of a clear message over a prolonged period to a big readership or audience.

Grants can be used to go towards the cost of identifying and preparing announcements, messages, programs or articles ready for broadcasting or publishing.

Grants cannot be used to go towards the cost of broadcasting time or newspaper space.

Applicants must be South Australian ethnic or multicultural organisations.

The projects could be in the form of:

- short but regular community announcements, messages or articles or
- extended programs or articles aimed at building broader understanding of the issues underpinning the campaign, or both.

These grants will, for example, help the media to call on listeners and readers to:

- celebrate and value multiculturalism;
- learn about the cultures of South Australians;
- accept South Australians from all backgrounds and respect their right to maintain and express their own cultures and faiths;
- take a stand against discrimination based on culture or faith;
- recognise the benefits of language learning for all; and
- promote understanding and respect across all ethnic communities of the special place of the many indigenous languages and cultures in Australia.

Projects should involve:

- a culturally diverse steering committee or other mechanism to demonstrate culturally diverse participation that will set and monitor the goals, strategies and fulfilment of the project;
- a clear process for the preparation of the announcements, programs, messages or articles;
- a firm pledge of the applicant(s) to provide the newspaper space or the broadcasting time for the announcements, programs messages or articles; and
- a management plan for the project.

These grants are not for the normal operating or capital costs of broadcasting or publishing.

WHAT CANNOT BE FUNDED THROUGH THIS SCHEME

These projects are not eligible for funding:

- projects for which there are more appropriate funding sources;
- projects by organisations established for profit or financial gain to members;
- food and drink;
- functions, excluding not-for-profit festivals, that charge an entrance fee;
- continuing social and club activities for which members' subscriptions provide a more appropriate source of revenue;
- activities of government agencies;
- continuing costs of newsletters, magazines and radio stations;
- projects that duplicate existing services available to the community;
- participation in interstate events;
- salaries/wages, except for up to 50% for those associated with Major Festivals, Major Projects and Events or a Major Community Development Grant;
- religious or political activities;
- prizes or competitions;
- English language/English conversation classes;
- retrospective funding for any functions or services;
- fundraising, other than for South Australian ethnic or multicultural organisations.

- enter into a Grant Agreement with the Minister for Multicultural Affairs;
- maintain full records of receipts of project expenditure;
- provide a full Accountability Statement upon the completion of the project and within 12 months of receipt of the grant;
- return to Multicultural S.A. all unspent funds or the equivalent of funds spent on purposes not approved for the grant;
- acknowledge the funding from the South Australian Government in all material and at any events associated with the project and in all publicity for the project;
- provide a report on the project to Multicultural S.A.

INSURANCE

- Grants recipients are strongly encouraged to obtain all permits, approvals, insurance covers etc. needed for the project; and, in particular, take out public liability or other insurance to cover loss or injury occurring to any person (whether visitor, volunteer or participant) at an event or activity that is part of a funded initiative or at a venue used for the purposes of an event or activity that is part of a funded initiative.

FINAL REPORTS

All successful applicants are required to provide a final report upon completion of the project. The final reports will help with the evaluations of the Grants Scheme and will enable future projects to benefit from the experience of others.

- long-term benefit to the applicant community.
