Interlink is an intensive and highly successful program which assists:

- Professionals
- Para professionals
- Trades people

to develop job search knowledge and skills to secure employment in their area of expertise. The 4 week (Monday – Thursday) Interlink Job-Search Program is run 8 times a year (depending on enrolment numbers).

Interlink will help you develop:

- confidence and self-marketing skills
- job search documents and applications
- industry networking skills
- knowledge of the Australian workplace, systems and culture
- strategies and skills for seeking skilled employment
- business communication skills

This is achieved through:

- lectures and workshops
- individual consultations and support
- group work
- familiarisation with government resources, agencies and legislation
- work experience placement, if appropriate (after completing the program)
- access to resources (computers, email, internet, newspapers, online materials)

To apply skilled migrants need:

- A good knowledge of English: ISLPR 3 or IELTS 6-7 and above, if you are not a native speaker of English
- Permanent residency status*
- To have recently arrived or PR status recently granted
- To be ready to work

**Subject to VISA subclass category – please check eligibility of your subclass (ie in 2007 SIR not eligible)*

To enrol, bring your:

- Curriculum Vitae/Resume
- Copies of your qualifications/skills
- Passport/Visa
- English Language test record, unless a native English speaker

A regulated course fee of approximately \$96 applies for the Interlink Program. This is subject to change. There is an additional fee if work experience is organised.
