GUIDELINES

NUMBER OF ENTRIES

A maximum of six (6) images per organisation.

IMAGE COMPOSITION

The eventual printed size of each image on the Calendar will be 3cm high by 2.8cm wide, as indicated by the box drawn here:



Hence the content of each photograph, once reduced to the above dimensions, will need to still be clearly recognisable as a face or artefact depicting a cultural background.

Close-up portraits of individuals are the most suitable. These types of photographs will make up the majority of images chosen for the Calendar. See examples below.

Alternatively, the image could be of a community member wearing traditional headdress or costume; a place of worship (or recognisable iconic aspect); clubrooms or other meeting places; food; utensils; festival elements such as fireworks, detail of a piece of artwork.



IMAGE RESOLUTION

High-resolution *digital* images that retain their quality when enlarged will be preferred. Multicultural S.A. may wish to use some images for other purposes, such as a display, which may involve enlarging them to A3 size.
